

Getting vaccinated with Kaiser Permanente

Steps for getting your COVID-19 vaccine

Federal and state authorities have announced that everyone age 16 and older will be eligible to receive the COVID-19 vaccine no later than May 1, 2021. Whether you're a Kaiser Permanente member or not, follow these steps to get your vaccine with us once you become eligible. If you are a current or former member, you'll need your medical record number (member ID).

Current or former Kaiser Permanente members:



- 1a** If you have internet access, sign in at kp.org/wa. No account? Set one up at kp.org/wa/register using the medical record number (member ID) on your membership card.¹
- After signing in, click on "COVID-19" and complete the "COVID-19 vaccination" e-visit to confirm your eligibility. Then schedule an appointment for your first shot.
- If you do not have internet access, call **1-800-352-3610** to schedule your first vaccine appointment.

Non-Kaiser Permanente members:



- 1b** All nonmembers should call **1-800-352-3610** to schedule your first vaccine appointment.²



- 2** Once you have an appointment, go to your appointed location to receive your first shot.



- 3** If you're receiving a two-dose vaccine: When you get your first shot, you'll be scheduled automatically for your second shot.



- 4** Go to your appointed location to receive your second shot. **Congratulations!** You're now vaccinated against COVID-19.



Help keep everyone safe

Continue to wash your hands, wear a mask, limit gatherings, and stay at least 6 feet away from people not in your household.

¹ If you are a current or former Kaiser Permanente member but don't have your member ID or want help setting up your account, call Member Services at 1-888-901-4636 (TTY 711), Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 8 p.m.

The COVID-19 vaccine will be provided at no out-of-pocket cost to you (we may bill your insurance company to administer the vaccine). Please follow the prompts for vaccination appointing only. Any other services or care you seek outside of the vaccination will be subject to normal costs and billing.

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
